Role Description

Purpose

Lead the effective and efficient delivery of mini and junior rugby at the club.

Key aspects of the role

1. Lead the AGR section, and lead a team of people to deliver rugby for 6–17-year-olds
2. Arrange and chair AGR team meetings, ensuring effective communication between the club, volunteers, players and parents.
3. Ensure that the best interests of the AGR Section are represented on the Executive Committee, including budget management.
4. Organise suitable recruitment, playing and training opportunities. Work alongside other club officers to coordinate the running and playing of mini and junior rugby training, games and tournaments in line with Age Grade Regulations.
5. Ensure all section members, players, coaches, volunteers and parents are familiar with and demonstrate the core values of the game.
6. Contribute to the development and implementation of the club's overall strategy.
