## DETAILED REPORT OF INCIDENT

From a lineout to Matlock IIs (Blue) on Worksop's (Black) 5m line Blue first mauled the ball and then subsequently peeled off in-field with Blue 6 (Braund) going over the line to score a try approximately 20m in from touch.

At this point, with Blue 6 laid on the floor Black 6 (Hainsworth) came in from the direction of touch and, with Blue 6 still laid on the floor punched him in the face causing him to bleed from the mouth. This provoked a reaction and with both players now on their feet in a group with others Blue 6 retaliated with 3 punches to the head of Black 6 - I could see no visible injury as a result. From a clear vantage point only 1m away I first blew the whistle first to award the try then again when Black 6 hit Blue 6 and again repeatedly whilst Blue 6 retaliated.

When the incident broke up I called to one side both Black 6 and Blue 6 together with their captains and explained that I had seen Black 6 punch Blue 6 for which he would be receiving a red card and that I had also witnessed the retaliatory punches thrown by Blue 6 for which he would also receive a red card. I then visually presented each player with a red card and dismissed them from the field of play.

At no point either immediately after the game or in the clubhouse after did Hainsworth show any remorse or apologise for his actions.
