ADDITIONAL FACTORS

Weather conditions and state of the pitch. General pattern of play/temper of game. Any other cards issued? Was there any injury/medical attention? Any other related information.

There had been rain overnight, and the pitch was squelchy underfoot. The grass was cut long.

The match was hard fought and the game was very close with both teams in a position to win the game. i had been clear and coached players through my decision making process.

We had moved scrums several times due to the pitch cutting up.

Both teams had been warned for appealing for decisions.

Men's Own had dominated the first half, Castle Donington had dominated the second half.

DETAILED REPORT OF INCIDENT

Men's Own, (Blue), were attacking the Castle Donington (Red) try line in the final 5 minutes of the second half. Red had given away three consecutive penalties between the try and 5m line and I issued a penalty warning to Red captain. Players from both both Blue and Red were down and I allowed treatment to be made these players.

Play resumed and Blue chose which position they wished from the three penalties.

Blue tapped and went and there was an infringement from Red for off feet and not rolling, so i called advantage and noted the number to give a Yellow Card. A ruck formed and Blue won the ball so I allowed play to continue with a view to issue a Yellow card.

Blue picked the ball from the base of the ruck and scored a try. I awarded the try and immediately Red 22 looked at me and shouted "Fuck off Ref." As he used the word Ref, I decided that this was directed at me, so issued a Red Card under law 9.28.

I called the player over with his captain, but Red chose to walk off. As he left the pitch I could hear "This is fucking bullshit" and "This he's got that fucking wrong" which I presumed to be directed towards me.

I was told by the team manager that the player had to leave immediately after the game to work, so was unable to make an apology. He apologised on his behalf.
