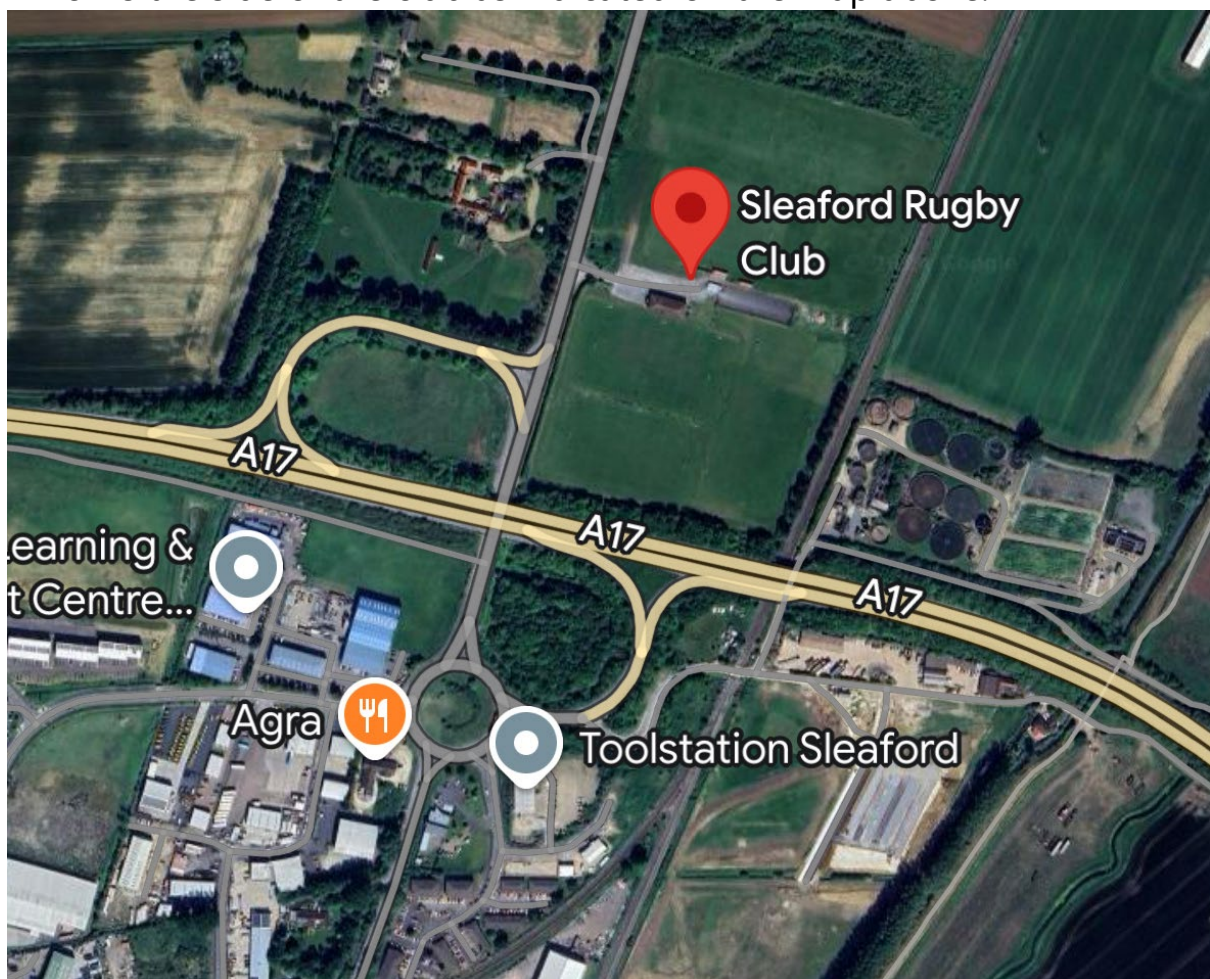

Disabled Parking

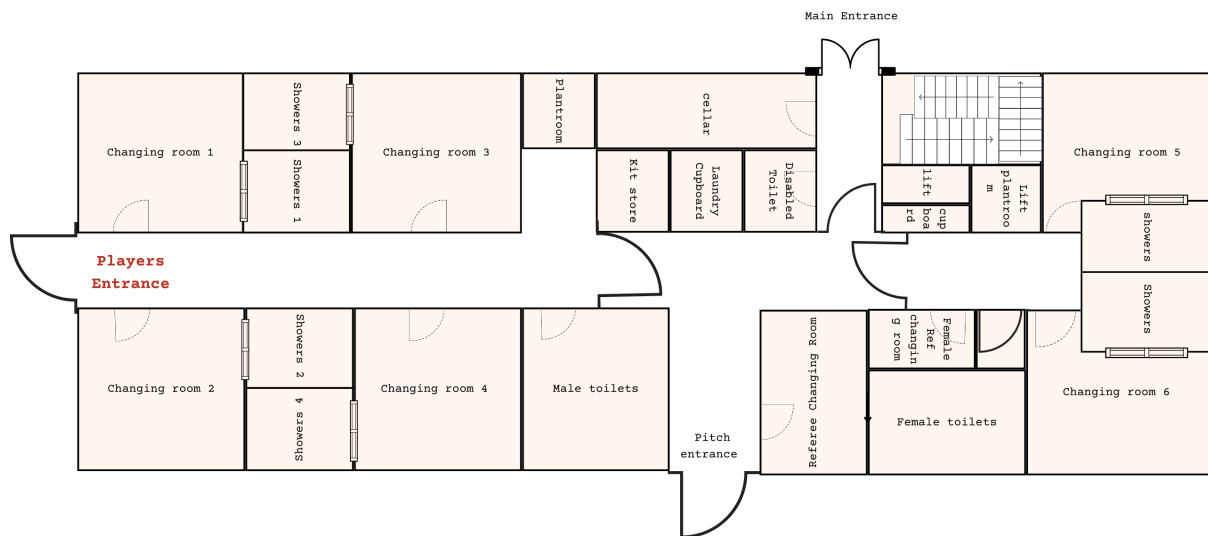
Please present your disabled parking pass to the parking attendants, and they will assign you a designated space.
