- 1. On admission from the university it was found that on the balance of probability the behaviour at Lincoln University constituted referee abuse and caused the match referee to submit an RFU match official abuse form (MoA Form).
- 2. The club (University) pleaded guilty to the charge of conduct prejudicial to the interests of the game, contrary to <u>RFU Rule 5.12</u>.
- 3. Lincoln University Students Union C.E.O. conducted internal investigations following written and electronic communications with Andrew Statham.
- 4. The University put the club (society) through their internal disciplinary process and was issued a final warning.
- 5. However since these issues were raised a separate incident has occurred not involving NLD Discipline and the club (society) has been suspended.
- 6. NLD disciplinary committee has accepted this process and supports the University in their actions against this behaviour of their Rugby Club.
- 7. A letter of apology was written by the University Mens Rugby President

Decision

12. The club (society)pleaded guilty and this was proven by the panel.

Right of Appeal

13. There is a right of appeal against this decision. Any such appeal must be lodged with the RFU Head of Discipline by
